

Innovative First Year Experience Program

The University of Tampa has specialized First Year Experience courses to meet the needs of a variety of entering students. First Year experience courses are one of several high impact practices that are built into Spartan Studies. Opportunities to participate in these designed high impact courses are available to all students. This requirement must be met at The University of Tampa and cannot be transferred in.

Entering First Year Students

Students that are starting their college career take a two-semester sequence of courses with a cohort of fellow students, a faculty member, and a peer mentor that has similar majors or interests. We strive to provide an environment where students can build community with one another, their faculty, and their peer mentor.

UTAMPA 101: Becoming a Spartan

This course is the first in a two-semester sequence that is required for all entering first year students. This course helps student achieve academic and personal goals by introducing them to campus resources, policies, and processes. This course also introduces students to the campus community and helps them build connections with fellow students, faculty, and staff.

Entering Transfer Students

A one-semester version of our first year experience course was developed, and is required, for all entering transfer students. Entering Veteran Students
